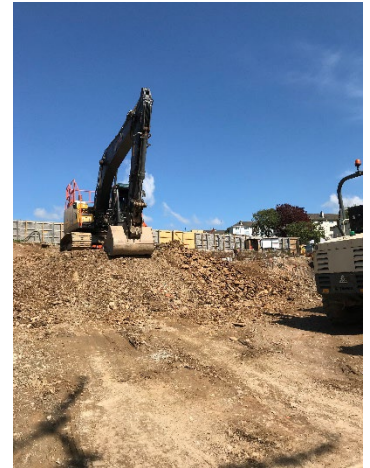

Welcome to our latest Barne Barton newsletter which provides an update on our regeneration plans for your local community.

## Demolition of homes

There has been continued good progress on the current demolition work, with the demolition of block nine (115 – 126 Savage Road) planned for November. Our contractor will be carrying out a 'soft strip' of the block ahead of the demolition and will have a site cabin based on Roope Close where you can speak to the team.

Thank you for your ongoing patience whilst demolition takes place. Whilst we have tried to keep disruption to a minimum, we recognise that this has caused some inconvenience.



## Building of new homes

We are pleased to share the news that construction of the first 28 new apartments on site is progressing to plan. In preparation for further works, machinery including a crane and silo base will be delivered to site in the next few weeks and stored at the top of Savage Road.



## Keeping you safe

We have agreed for the installation of CCTV across the estate to ensure your safety and help identify any incidents of antisocial behaviour. We are working to agree a date for installation and will let you know when this will be. We encourage you to report any incidents as they occur to the police, STAR and your local Housing Officers.
