Welcome to the latest issue of our Beechwood Village newsletter.

I'm pleased to be able to share good news about our progress since my last update.

A further 79 homes on Phase West have been released for a mix of affordable rent and private sale. This comes after Basildon Council transferred the land to Sanctuary.

We have now entered a demolition contract with Keltbray. Survey works and hoarding of the site is underway. Once we've finished the demolition we will start construction works to deliver a further 96 homes.

I'm proud that together these 175 new homes will be over 60% affordable.

Beechwood West has created 667 much-needed new homes

A total of 588 homes were completed on Phase West between 2020 and 2023. A further 79 homes have now been released following the signing of a land transfer agreement with Basildon Council.

The owners have started to move into their new houses and tenants will be able to move into the flats later in the year.



Demolition starting on Beechwood North

Our demolition contractor, Keltbray, has started on site surveys and hoarding works ahead of demolition starting in May 2024. The demolition is expected to take five months.

If you live near the site, we will keep you up-todate throughout these works.

This land will be used to build 96 new homes. As we updated you in our last newsletter, we've been working with the architect to make some minor improvements to the design. For example, we're proposing to move the parking so that it is outside people's homes rather than on the ring road surrounding the new homes. We're also proposing to add private gardens for the flats. We are in consultation with Basildon Council's planning team to get these changes approved.
