

Moving in checklist

When you move in to your new home, there are a few things to remember: ☐ Contact your gas, water and electricity suppliers to set up or change your utilities account ☐ Take meter readings as soon as you move in (these are usually taken as part of the tenancy sign up process) ☐ Contact your local council to set up or change your Council Tax payments and to add your household to the electoral roll ☐ Contact your local council to make a claim for Housing Benefit and Council Tax Benefit (if applicable) ☐ Find out where your stop taps, fuse box and trip switch are located (contact your Housing Officer if you need help) ☐ Arrange contents insurance for your personal belongings (building insurance is already set up for your property) ☐ Re-direct your mail from your previous address (please contact the Post Office for advice) ☐ Arrange or amend your TV licence (if necessary) ☐ If you install a phone, please let us know your landline number ☐ Remember to let your doctor, dentist, bank, employer, school and DVLA, etc of your new address
