

# Keeping you **gas safe!**

There are some key things which keep you, your loved ones and your homes safe with regards to gas safety



## Gas safety checks

By law, we must carry out an annual gas service and safety check of all gas appliances in your home. A safe two-metre distance will be observed, but if you or someone in your home is self-isolating or shielding please let us know ahead of your annual check.

## Top tips!

### DO

- Have your gas appliances checked annually by Sanctuary
- Use gas appliances for their intended purposes only
- Ask to see your engineer's **Gas Safety Register ID card** and look at both the front and the back of the card
- Check for warning signs that appliances are not working correctly

### DON'T

- Block air vents or chimneys, they are there to ensure your gas appliances are working safely
- Risk it and try DIY with gas appliances, always use a Gas Safe registered engineer
- Ignore the symptoms of carbon monoxide poisoning, which can include headaches, nausea and dizziness

**If you smell gas - open all doors and windows, shut off the gas supply at your gas meter, put out all sources of ignition or naked flames, leave the building and call National Grid's gas emergency freephone number 0800 111 999 and contact us on 0800 131 3348. Do not smoke, light flames, turn any switches on or off, or use telephones - including mobiles indoors.**
